A BILL to amend and reenact §2-2-1a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to establishing special memorial days for certain military veterans; declaring March 30 as a special memorial day to be known as Vietnam Veteran Recognition Day; declaring August 7 as a special memorial day to be known as Purple Heart Recognition Day; and declaring July 27 as a special memorial day to be known as Korean War Veteran Recognition Day.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §2-2-1a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 2. LEGAL HOLIDAYS; SPECIAL MEMORIAL DAYS; CONSTRUCTION OF STATUTES; DEFINITIONS.

## §2-2-1a. Special memorial days.

- 1 (a) The Governor shall, by proclamation, declare the
- 2 week beginning with the Sunday before Thanksgiving as a
- 3 special memorial week to be known as Native American
- 4 Indian Heritage Week.
- 5 (b) The first Tuesday after the first Monday of November
- 6 is designated Susan B. Anthony Day and shall only be a legal
- 7 holiday in all years ending in an even number. The Governor
- 8 shall annually issue a proclamation calling on all schools, civic
- 9 organizations, government departments and citizens to
- 10 undertake activities on the designated day and surrounding
- 11 days to pay tribute to the accomplishments of Susan B.
- 12 Anthony in securing the civil and political rights of all
- 13 Americans, including securing equal voting rights for women.

- 14 (c) The Governor shall, by proclamation, declare
- 15 December 7 as a special memorial day, to be known as Pearl
- 16 Harbor Day, honoring all West Virginians who fought in
- World War II and shall encourage all municipalities in the
- 18 state to do the same.
- 19 (d) The Governor shall, by proclamation, declare March
- 20 30 as a special memorial day to be known as Vietnam
- 21 <u>Veteran Recognition Day honoring all West Virginians who</u>
- 22 served in the United States Armed Forces in the Republic of
- Vietnam during the period beginning February 28, 1961 and
- 24 ending May 7, 1975, and shall encourage all counties and
- 25 municipalities in the state to do the same.
- 26 (e) The Governor shall, by proclamation, declare August
- 27 7 as a special memorial day, to be known as Purple Heart
- 28 Recognition Day, honoring all West Virginians who, while
- 29 serving in the United States Armed Forces, have been
- 30 wounded or killed in action and shall encourage all
- 31 municipalities and counties in the state to do the same.

- 32 (f) The Governor shall, by proclamation, declare July 27
- 33 <u>as a special memorial day to be known as Korean War</u>
- 34 Veteran Recognition Day honoring all West Virginians who
- 35 served in the United States Armed Forces in the Korean War,
- 36 and shall encourage all counties and municipalities in the
- 37 <u>state to do the same.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of the bill is to make March 30 a special memorial day to be known as Vietnam Veteran Recognition Day; to make August 7 a special memorial day to be known as Purple Heart Recognition Day; and declaring July 27 as a special memorial day to be known as Korean War Veteran Recognition Day.
