A BILL to amend and reenact §9-5-18 of the Code of West Virginia,

1931, as amended, relating to funeral expenses for indigent

persons; and restricting payments for burial services of

indigents to only those services provided by a funeral director

licensed by West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §9-5-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,

be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

## **ARTICLE 5. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.**

## §9-5-18. Funeral expenses for indigent persons; filing of affidavit to certify indigency; penalties for false swearing; payment by division.

- 1 (a) The Department of Health and Human Resources
- 2 shall pay for reasonable funeral service expenses for indigent
- 3 persons, in an amount not to exceed \$1,250.

4 (b) For purposes of this section, the indigency of a 5 deceased person is determined by the filing of an affidavit 6 with the department, in a form provided by and determined 7 in accordance with the income guidelines as set forth by the 8 department: (1) Signed by the heir or heirs-at-law which 9 states that the estate of the deceased person is pecuniarily 10 unable to pay the costs associated with a funeral; or (2) 11 signed by the county coroner or the county health officer, the 12 attending physician or other person signing the death 13 certificate or the state medical examiner stating that the deceased person has no heirs or that heirs have not been 14 15 located after a reasonable search and that the deceased person had no estate or the estate is pecuniarily unable to pay the 16 17 costs associated with a funeral.

18 (c) Payment shall be made by the department to the 19 person or persons who have furnished the services and 20 supplies for the indigent person's funeral expenses or to the 21 persons who have advanced payment for same, as the 22 department may determine, pursuant to appropriations for 23 expenditures made by the Legislature for such that purpose.

(d) For purposes of this section, "reasonable funeral 24 25 service expenses" means expenses for services provided by 26 a West Virginia licensed funeral director for the disposition 27 of human remains. (e) Any person who knowingly swears falsely in an 28 29 affidavit required by this section shall be is guilty of a 30 misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than \$1,000 or confined in the county or regional jail 31 for a period of not more than six months, or both. 32

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to restrict payments for burial services of indigents to only those services provided by a funeral director licensed by West Virginia.
