1           The Committee on Finance moves to amend the bill on page five,  
2 section two, line eighteen, following the words "joining together",  
3 by striking out the word "one" and inserting in lieu thereof the  
4 word "two";

5           On page six, section two, line thirty, following the period,  
6 by inserting the sentence "In the case of the consolidation of  
7 Bridgemont Community and Technical College and Kanawha Valley  
8 Community and Technical College, "multicampus institution" means  
9 the consolidated institution comprised of existing campuses in  
10 Montgomery and South Charleston and any other campuses that may be  
11 established in the future, in accordance with the Higher Learning  
12 Commission standards of accreditation.";

13           On page seven, section three, line seven, preceding the  
14 period, by inserting a comma, followed by the words "and to  
15 continued fulfillment of institutional accreditation requirements";

16           On page eight, section three, line thirty-three, by striking  
17 out the words "apportion the appointments as equally as possible  
18 among the lay citizen members" and inserting in lieu thereof the  
19 words "appoint an equal number of lay citizen members from each";

20           On page eight, section three, line thirty-five, following the  
21 period by inserting the following sentence: "One such member serves  
22 a one-year term only, after which that membership position is not  
23 reappointed."

24           On page nine, section three, line thirty-six, following the  
25 subdivision designation "(2)", by inserting the words "One of the

1 initial appointments is for a term of one year,";

2 On page nine, section three, line thirty-eight, following the  
3 period, by inserting the following: "(3) Until June 30, 2014, all  
4 of the constituent members of the boards of governors of the  
5 affected institutions representing faculty, classified employees  
6 and students serve as members on the board of governors of the  
7 reorganized institution. Beginning July 1, 2014, the constituent  
8 members of the reorganized institution are appointed according to  
9 the provisions of section one, article two-a of this chapter.";

10 On page nine, section three, by striking out all of lines  
11 forty-four through fifty-one, and by redesignating the remaining  
12 subsection accordingly;

13 On page thirteen, section six, by striking out lines one and  
14 two in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
15 "When a consolidated institution is formed:

16 (1) The operating budget of each affected institution is  
17 integrated", and by redesignating the remaining paragraphs of the  
18 section as numbered subdivisions accordingly;

19 On page nineteen, section nine, beginning on line one, by  
20 inserting a new subsection (a) to read as follows: "(a) When a  
21 consolidated institution is formed, the faculty, classified  
22 employees and nonclassified employees of the affected institutions  
23 become the faculty, classified employees and nonclassified  
24 employees of the consolidated institution, subject to the  
25 provisions of this article.", and by redesignating the remaining  
26 subsections accordingly;

27 On page twenty-one, following line thirty-eight, by adding a  
28 new section to read as follows:

1 **§18B-3F-10. Transfer of students.**

2 (a) When a consolidated institution is formed, the students of  
3 the affected institutions become the students of the consolidated  
4 institution, subject to the provisions of section eight, article  
5 one of this chapter.”;

6 And,

7 On page two, by striking out the enacting section and  
8 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 “That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
10 by adding thereto a new article, designated §18B-3F-1, §18B-3F-2,  
11 §18B-3F-3, §18B-3F-4, §18B-3F-5, §18B-3F-6, §18B-3F-7, §18B-3F-8,  
12 §18B-3F-9 and §18B-3F-10, all to read as follows:”.
