10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$8A-12-2$ of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to requiring county commissions to
12	adopt and implement county farmland protection programs.
13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
14	That §8A-12-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
15	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
16	ARTICLE 12. VOLUNTARY FARMLAND PROTECTION PROGRAMS.
17	§8A-12-2. County farmland protection programs and farmland
18	protection boards authorized; authority of county
19	commission to approve purchase of farmland
20	easements; expense reimbursement of actual expenses
21	for the board members.
22	(a) The county commission of each county may shall adopt and
23	implement a farmland protection program within the county. The

- 1 county commission of each county which decides to adopt and
- 2 implement a farmland protection program shall appoint a farmland
- 3 protection board. The farmland protection board shall administer
- 4 on behalf of the county commission all matters concerning farmland
- 5 protection. The county commission has final approval authority for
- 6 any and all purchases of easements for the farmland protection
- 7 program by the board.
- 8 (b) The farmland protection board shall adopt bylaws
- 9 prescribing the board's officers, meeting dates, record-keeping
- 10 procedures, meeting attendance requirements and other internal
- 11 operational procedures. The member of the farmland protection
- 12 board who is a county commissioner shall serve as temporary
- 13 chairman of the board until the board's bylaws are adopted and
- 14 until the board's officers are selected as prescribed by those
- 15 bylaws. The farmland protection board shall prepare a document
- 16 proposing a farmland protection program which is consistent with
- 17 the Legislature's intent.
- 18 (c) Each member of the board shall receive expense
- 19 reimbursement for actual expenses incurred while engaged in the
- 20 discharge of official duties, the actual expenses not to exceed the
- 21 amount paid to members of the Legislature.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require county commissions to adopt and implement county farmland protection programs.
