A BILL to repeal §47-19-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as  
amended, relating to requiring license to sell paraphernalia

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**§1 Repeal of section requiring license to sell paraphernalia for  
use with controlled substances.**
