That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.
<pre>§64-9-1. Commissioner of Agriculture.</pre>
The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
the authority of section two, article nine, chapter nineteen, of
this code, relating to the Commissioner of Agriculture (animal
disease control, <u>61 CSR 1</u>), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Animal Disease Control.
