22	§64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.
23	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
24	twenty-ninth day of June, two thousand twelve, authorized under the

authority of section six, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty, of this code, relating to the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists (procedures, criteria and curricula for examination and licensure of barbers, cosmetologists, nail technicians, aestheticians and hair stylists, 3 CSR 1), is authorized.
