15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17	as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
19	PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.
20	§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.
21	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
22	twenty-fourth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
23	the authority of section seventeen, article eighteen, chapter
24	twenty-two, of this code, relating to the Department of

Environmental Protection (hazardous waste administrative proceedings and civil penalty assessment, 33 CSR 27), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Hazardous Waste Administrative Proceedings and Civil Penalty Assessment.
