19	§64-7-1. Athletic Commission.
20	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
21	twenty-seventh day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
22	the authority of section three-a, article five-a, chapter twenty-
23	nine, of this code, modified by the Athletic Commission to meet the
24	objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
25	refiled in the State Register on the eighteenth day of October, two

thousand twelve, relating to the Athletic Commission (mixed martial

arts, 177 CSR 2), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Athletic Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Mixed Martial Arts.
