21	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
22	thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
23	the authority of section five-a, article nine, chapter sixty-a, of
24	this code, modified by the Board of Dental Examiners to meet the

objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on the sixth day of December, two thousand twelve, relating to the Board of Dental Examiners (practitioner requirements for accessing the West Virginia controlled substances monitoring program database, <u>5 CSR 10</u>), is authorized.
