10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Board of Dental Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule
13 relating to practitioner requirements for accessing the West
14 Virginia controlled substances monitoring program database.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Board of Dental Examiners.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
22 thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
23 the authority of section five-a, article nine, chapter sixty-a, of
24 this code, modified by the Board of Dental Examiners to meet the

1 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
2 refiled in the State Register on the sixth day of December, two
3 thousand twelve, relating to the Board of Dental Examiners
4 (practitioner requirements for accessing the West Virginia
5 controlled substances monitoring program database, [5 CSR 10](#)), is
6 authorized.

8 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
9 Dental Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
10 Practitioner Requirements for Accessing the West Virginia
11 Controlled Substances Monitoring Program Database.
