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10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to  
13 promulgate a legislative rule relating to the protocol for law  
14 enforcement response to child abuse and neglect.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**  
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the  
22 sixteenth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under the  
23 authority of section five, article nine, chapter fifteen, of this  
24 code, modified by the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency  
25 and Correction to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-  
26 Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on the

1 fifth day of December, two thousand twelve, relating to the  
2 Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction (protocol  
3 for law enforcement response to child abuse and neglect, [149 CSR](#)  
4 [8](#)), is authorized.

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6 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor's  
7 Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to promulgate a  
8 legislative rule relating to the Protocol for Law Enforcement  
9 Response to Child Abuse and Neglect.

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11 This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and  
12 underscoring have been omitted.
