10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to  
13 promulgate a legislative rule relating to the announcement of  
14 advanced practice.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**  
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the second  
22 day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under the authority  
23 of section one, article seven, chapter thirty, of this code,  
24 modified by the Board of Examiners for Registered Professional  
25 Nurses to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review  
26 Committee and refiled in the State Register on the seventh day of

1 December, two thousand twelve, relating to the Board of Examiners  
2 for Registered Professional Nurses (announcement of advanced  
3 practice, [19 CSR 7](#)), is authorized.

5 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of  
6 Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a  
7 legislative rule relating to the Announcement of Advanced Practice.
