24	State to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review

Committee and refiled in the State Register on the eighteenth day
of January, two thousand thirteen, relating to the Secretary of
State (administration of the address confidentiality program, <u>153</u>
<u>CSR 37</u>), is authorized.
