22	(a)(1) Except as needed for purposes of a legitimate

- 1 investigation of a crime, no person may photograph a corpse.
- 2 (2) A person who violates subdivision (1) of this subsection
- 3 is guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction, shall be fined
- 4 not less than \$50 nor more than \$500. For a second offense the
- 5 person is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof,
- 6 shall be confined in jail for twenty-four hours and shall be fined
- 7 not less than \$100 nor more than \$750. For a third or subsequent
