10 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11 adding thereto a new section, designated §21-5A-12, relating
12 to exempting construction performed on behalf of educational
13 authorities from prevailing wage requirements.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
16 by adding thereto a new section, designated §21-5A-12, to read as
17 follows:

18 **ARTICLE 5A. WAGES FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS.**

19 **§21-5A-12. Exemption.**

20 The provisions of this article do not apply to construction
21 performed on behalf of any educational authority, including, but
22 not limited to, a county board of education, the Higher Education
23 Policy Commission and the School Building Authority.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to exempt construction performed on behalf of any educational authority from the prevailing wage laws.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
