18	The term "proof of financial responsibility" as used in this
19	chapter shall mean means: Proof of ability to respond in damages
20	for liability, on account of accident occurring subsequent to the
21	effective date of said the proof, arising out of the ownership,
22	operation, maintenance or use of a motor vehicle, trailer or
23	semitrailer in the amount of $\frac{20,000}{50,000}$ because of bodily
24	injury to or death of one person in any one accident, and, subject

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1 to said the limit for one person, in the amount of \$40,000 \$100,0002 because of bodily injury to or death of two or more persons in any 3 one accident, and in the amount of \$10,000 \$25,000 because of 4 injury to or destruction of property of others in any one accident.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the minimum proof of financial responsibility in motor vehicle insurance coverage.
