- 1 Provided, That fees allocated for consulting services in the fiscal
- 2 year commencing July 1, 2013, and for each fiscal year thereafter
- 3 can be no greater than ninety percent of those expended in the
- 4 fiscal year commencing July 1, 2012.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create a requirement for itemization of, and limitation upon, consulting fees.
