3 counterproductive or outdated so that the administrative burden on

5 (b) The state board shall submit a report to the Legislative
6 Oversight Commission on Education Accountability no later than
7 December 31 of each year identifying those unnecessary reports,
8 together with any comments and recommendations on how to reduce or
9 consolidate principal and teacher reports.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to direct the State Board of Education to determine what principal and teacher reports are unnecessary. The bill requires the state board to identify these reports to the Legislature with recommendations on how to lessen the administrative burden of these reports on principals and teachers.
