6 Requesting the Division of Highways to name bridge number
7 23-119/5-1.80 on County Route 119/5 in Logan County, the "Army
8 Corporal Randell Maynard Bridge".

9 WHEREAS, Corporal Maynard was born on July 31, 1946 in Omar to
10 Grady and Sarah Maynard; and

11 WHEREAS, Corporal Maynard graduated from Logan High School in
12 1964; and

13 WHEREAS, Corporal Maynard entered the United States Army in
14 September 1966 and was honorably discharged in September 1968 after
15 serving in Vietnam; and

16 WHEREAS, In June 1969 Corporal Maynard married Sharon Simms and
17 they raised three children, Matt, Sherry and Jason; and

18 WHEREAS, Following his military service Corporal Maynard was
19 employed in mining construction and retired in 1996; and

20 WHEREAS, Corporal Maynard has long been involved with his
21 community, including tirelessly working with the Omar Little League
22 and the annual Pine Creek Reunion; and

23 WHEREAS, It is fitting to honor Corporal Maynard for his
24 commitment, dedication and service to his country and his state;

1 therefore, be it

2 *Resolved by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

3 That the Division of Highways is hereby requested to name
4 bridge number 23-119/5-1.80 on County Route 119/5 in Logan County,
5 the "Army Corporal Randell Maynard Bridge"; and, be it

6 *Further Resolved,* That the Division of Highways is requested
7 to have made and be placed signs identifying the bridge as the
8 "Army Corporal Randell Maynard Bridge"; and, be it

9 *Further Resolved,* That the Clerk of the House of Delegates
10 forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Secretary of the
11 Department of Transportation and Army Corporal Randell Maynard.
