16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
17	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
18	by adding thereto a new section, designated §36-3-8a, to read as
19	follows:
20	ARTICLE 3. FORM AND EFFECT OF DEEDS AND CONTRACTS.
21	§36-3-8a. Surface owners' rights to purchase mineral estates.
22	Beginning January 1, 2014, an owner of a mineral estate shall
23	give the surface owner the right of first refusal to purchase the

1 mineral estate in the event the mineral estate is sold.

NOTE: The purpose if the bill is to grant a surface owner the right to purchase a mineral estate in the event the mineral estate is sold.
