12 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
13 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
14 Board of Dental Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule
15 relating to practitioner requirements for accessing the West
16 Virginia controlled substances monitoring program database.

17 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

18 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
19 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

20 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
21 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

22 **§64-9-1. Board of Dental Examiners.**

23 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
24 thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under

1 the authority of section five-a, article nine, chapter sixty-a, of
2 this code, modified by the Board of Dental Examiners to meet the
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
4 refiled in the State Register on the sixth day of December, two
5 thousand twelve, relating to the Board of Dental Examiners
6 (practitioner requirements for accessing the West Virginia
7 controlled substances monitoring program database, [5 CSR 10](#)), is
8 authorized.

10 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
11 Dental Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
12 Practitioner Requirements for Accessing the West Virginia
13 Controlled Substances Monitoring Program Database.
