12 A BILL to amend and reenact article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of  
13 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
14 Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a  
15 legislative rule relating to permits for construction and  
16 major modification of major stationary sources for the  
17 prevention of significant deterioration of air quality.

18 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

19 That article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
20 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

21 **ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL**  
22 **PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

23 **§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.**

24 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the

1 fifteenth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under the  
2 authority of section four, article five, chapter twenty-two, of  
3 this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection  
4 (permits for construction and major modification of major  
5 stationary sources for the prevention of significant deterioration  
6 of air quality, [45 CSR 14](#)), is authorized.

8 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department  
9 of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule  
10 relating to Permits for Construction and Major Modification of  
11 Major Stationary Sources for the Prevention of Significant  
12 Deterioration of Air Quality.
