12 A BILL to amend and reenact article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of
13 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
14 Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a
15 legislative rule relating to standards of performance for new
16 stationary sources.

17 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

18 That article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
19 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

20 **ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL**
21 **PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

22 **§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.**

23 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
24 fourteenth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under the

1 authority of section four, article five, chapter twenty-two, of
2 this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection
3 (standards of performance for new stationary sources, [45 CSR 16](#)),
4 is authorized.

6 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department
7 of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
8 relating to Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources.
