11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of  
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
13 Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a  
14 legislative rule relating to covered electronic devices  
15 recycling.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
18 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL**  
20 **PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

21 **§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.**

22 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the  
23 thirtieth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under the  
24 authority of section twenty-nine, article fifteen-a, chapter

1 twenty-two, of this code, modified by the Department of  
2 Environmental Protection to meet the objections of the Legislative  
3 Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 the thirteenth day of December, two thousand twelve, relating to  
5 the Department of Environmental Protection (covered electronic  
6 devices recycling, [33 CSR 12](#)), is authorized.

8 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department  
9 of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule  
10 relating to Covered Electronic Devices Recycling.
