A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of

13

West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the

14

Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to

15

promulgate a legislative rule relating to law-enforcement

16

training and certification standards.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,

as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO

PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the

24

thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under

25

the authority of section three, article twenty-nine, chapter

26

thirty, of this code, relating to the Governor's Committee on

1 Crime, Delinquency and Correction (law enforcement training and
2 certification standards, [149 CSR 2](#)), is authorized.

3

4 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor's
5 Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Correction to promulgate a
6 legislative rule relating to Law Enforcement Training and
7 Certification Standards.
