20	ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
21	PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.
22	§64-9-1. Board of Medicine.
23	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
24	twenty-eighth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
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the authority of section seven, article three, chapter thirty, of this code, modified by the Board of Medicine to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on the sixth day of December, two thousand twelve, relating to the Board of Medicine (licensure, disciplinary and complaint procedures; continuing education; and physician assistants, <u>11 CSR 1B</u>), is authorized.
