12 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
13 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
14 Division of Protective Services to promulgate a legislative
15 rule relating to contracted police or security services.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
18 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND**
20 **PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

21 **§64-9-1. Division of Protective Services.**

22 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
23 thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
24 the authority of section three, article two-d, chapter fifteen of
25 this code, modified by the Division of Protective Services to meet
26 the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and

1 refiled in the State Register on the seventeenth day of January,
2 two thousand thirteen, relating to the Division of Protective
3 Services (contracted police or security services, [99 CSR 5](#)), is
4 authorized.

6 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of
7 Protective Services to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
8 Contracted Police or Security Services.
