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11 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
12 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
13 Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating
14 to administration of the Address Confidentiality Program.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Secretary of State.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
22 fourteenth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under the
23 authority of section one hundred ten, article twenty-eight-a,
24 chapter forty-eight, of this code, modified by the Secretary of

1 State to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review
2 Committee and refiled in the State Register on the eighteenth day
3 of January, two thousand thirteen, relating to the Secretary of
4 State (administration of the address confidentiality program, [153](#)
5 [CSR 37](#)), is authorized.

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7 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Secretary
8 of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Administration
9 of the Address Confidentiality Program.
