12 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of  
13 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
14 Bureau of Senior Services to promulgate a legislative rule  
15 relating to the in-home care worker registry.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
18 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN**  
20 **RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

21 **§64-5-1. Bureau of Senior Services.**

22 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the  
23 thirty-first day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under  
24 the authority of section fifteen, article five-p, chapter sixteen,

1 of this code, modified by the Bureau of Senior Services to meet the  
2 objections of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and  
3 refiled in the State Register on the seventeenth day of January,  
4 two thousand thirteen, relating to the Bureau of Senior Services  
5 (in-home care worker registry, [76 CSR 2](#)), is authorized.

7 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Bureau of  
8 Senior Services to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the  
9 In-home Care Worker Registry.
