22	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on the
23	twenty-eighth day of August, two thousand twelve, authorized under
24	the authority of section four, article one, chapter thirty, of this

code, modified by the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on the twelfth day of December, two thousand twelve, relating to the Board of Osteopathic Medicine (osteopathic physician assistants, <u>24 CSR 2</u>), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Osteopathic Physician Assistants.
