1 An employee may be eligible to donate accrued sick leave if the 2 donated sick leave will not reduce the employee's sick leave 3 balance below twenty days. The annual and sick leave donation 4 program shall be established by legislative rule pursuant to the 5 provisions of article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code. 6 The Division of Personnel shall file such legislative rule no later 7 than July 15, 1995. The division shall prepare an annual status 8 report to be presented to the Joint Committee on Government and 9 Finance no later than January 5, each year. A "medical emergency" 10 means a medical condition of an employee or a family member of the 11 employee that is likely to require the prolonged absence of the 12 employee from duty and which will result in a substantial loss of 13 income to the employee because of the unavailability of paid leave. 14 As used in this section, "employee" includes employees in the 15 classified and classified-exempt service and employees exempt from 16 coverage who are under this article entitled to annual and sick 17 leave as a benefit of employment: Provided, That none of the leave 18 so transferred may be used to qualify for or add to service for any 19 retirement system administered by the State of West Virginia.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow certain eligible employees to donate accumulated sick leave to other employees who are eligible to participate in the leave donation program.
