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PART III. FEES AND DEALER SPECIAL PLATES GENERALLY.

2 §17A-6-10c. Special demonstration plates for dealers in trailers,
3 truck-tractors, road-tractors and trucks;
4 application; fee.

5 (a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this code, any <u>a</u> 6 new motor vehicle dealer or used motor vehicle dealer engaged in 7 the business of selling trailers, truck-tractors, road-tractors or 8 trucks who demonstrates <u>that demonstrates</u> the motor vehicles under 9 actual work conditions to potential purchasers shall obtain a 10 special demonstration plate from the Division of Motor Vehicles. 11 The motor vehicle dealer may obtain special demonstration plates 12 without first titling or registering each vehicle.

(b) The commissioner shall prescribe the application form for these special demonstration plates and shall require the applicant to submit proof of the applicant's status as a bona fide dealer in motor vehicles and to certify that the applicant needs special demonstration plates in the ordinary course of business.

18 The commissioner, upon approving any <u>an</u> application, shall 19 issue to the new motor vehicle dealer or used motor vehicle dealer 20 up to four special demonstration plates which <del>shall</del> display the 21 term "demonstration" or "demo" and a distinguishing number assigned 22 to the motor vehicle dealer. <u>The commissioner may issue no more</u> 23 than ten additional special demonstration plates at the fee of \$50

1 for each additional plate upon a showing that the licensee has
2 sales or potential sales justifying additional plates. This
3 showing may include, but is not limited to, the dealer's on-site
4 inventory of the applicable type of vehicles, previous sales to
5 residents and nonresidents of applicable vehicles or the
6 geographical divergence of the dealer's customer base.

7 (c) The annual fee for special demonstration plates is \$100 8 for the first plate and \$50 for each additional plate, not to 9 exceed a total of four fourteen plates per dealer.

10 (d) Each motor vehicle dealer who is issued special 11 demonstration plates shall keep a written record, on a form 12 approved by the commissioner <u>and open to inspection by a police</u> 13 <u>officer or employee of the division</u>, containing the following 14 information:

15 (1) Identification of the motor vehicles upon which the 16 special demonstration plates are used;

17 <u>(2)</u> The times and dates during which each special 18 demonstration plate is used;

19 <u>(3)</u> The name and address of the company or individual using a 20 motor vehicle on which a special demonstration plate is used; and 21 <u>(4)</u> any Other information considered necessary by the 22 commissioner. This record shall be open to inspection by any 23 police officer or employee of the division.

1 (e) Each motor vehicle operated under the provisions of this 2 section is considered to be registered at the maximum vehicle 3 weights allowable under article seventeen, chapter seventeen-c of 4 this code.

5 (f) A motor vehicle dealer shall not:

6 (1) Use <u>any a</u> special demonstration <u>plates plate</u> issued under 7 the provisions of this section on <u>any a</u> motor vehicle which is not 8 being demonstrated;

9 (2) Use <u>any <u>a</u> special demonstration <del>plates</del> <u>plate</u> to 10 demonstrate <u>any <u>a</u> single motor vehicle for more than seven calendar 11 days in <del>any <u>a</u> calendar year for <u>any <u>a</u> single customer;</del></u></u></del></u>

12 (3) Use any <u>a</u> special demonstration <del>plates on any</del> <u>plate on a</u>
13 motor vehicle leased or rented to any <u>a</u> customer; or

14 (4) Use any <u>a</u> special demonstration <u>plates</u> <u>plate</u> in any way 15 other than to demonstrate the on-the-job capabilities of a motor 16 vehicle to a potential purchaser.

17 (g) The motor vehicle dealer is required to furnish a 18 certificate of insurance in the amount required by regulations of 19 the West Virginia Public Service Commission or the United States 20 Department of Transportation for the class of motor carrier for 21 which the motor vehicle is to be demonstrated.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the cap on the number of demonstration dealer plates that may be issued to new and used dealers of large, commercial type vehicles.
