

1 (b) The state board shall appoint, subject to the advice and
2 consent of the Senate, a State Superintendent of Schools. The State
3 Superintendent ~~shall be~~ is the chief executive officer of the state
4 board and, subject to its direction, shall execute its policies.

5 (c) The state board shall appoint a secretary and fix the
6 secretary's salary to be paid out of the General School Fund upon
7 warrants drawn by the State Superintendent. The secretary shall
8 keep a record of the proceedings of the state board and shall
9 perform ~~such~~ other duties as it may prescribe.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the appointment of the State Superintendent of Schools be with the advice and consent of the Senate.
