22	The county board of every county, within ninety days after the
23	beginning of each fiscal year, shall prepare on a form to be

Such A notice of 15 availability of the statement shall be published as a Class I-0 16 legal advertisement in compliance with the provisions of article 17 three, chapter fifty-nine of this code, and the publication area 18 for such the publication shall be is the county. The county board 19 shall pay the cost of publishing such statement the notice from the 20 maintenance general fund of the board.

22 year, a copy of the published statement herein required shall be 23 filed by the county board with the State Tax Commissioner and with 24 the State Superintendent of free Schools.

As soon as is practicable following the close of the fiscal

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The county board shall transmit to any resident of the county requesting the same it a copy of the published statement for the siscal year designated, supplemented by a list of the names of all school personnel employed by the board during such the fiscal year showing the amount paid to each, and a list of the names of each firm, corporation, and person who received less than \$500 from any fund during such the fiscal year showing the amount paid to each and the purpose for which paid.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that after a county board of education has prepared its annual financial statement only a notice of availability of the statement must be published. The bill also provides that the cost of publishing the notice be paid from the board's general fund.
