10	A BILL to amend and reenact §12-3-18 of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to payment of claims by a body
12	charged with the administration of the fiscal affairs of any

15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That §12-3-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
17	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 3. APPROPRIATIONS, EXPENDITURES AND DEDUCTIONS.
19	§12-3-18. Paying itemized statement of claims against counties,
20	school districts or municipalities.
21	It shall be unlawful for any county court Every county
	<pre>commission, board of education or the council of a municipal</pre>
	corporation, or other body charged with the administration of the

1 fiscal affairs of any county, school district, independent school 2 district or municipality, to shall pay any properly authorized 3 itemized claim for services rendered or materials furnished unless 4 an itemized account therefor is filed by the claimant covering the 5 claim. Such account shall be itemized in detail, and shall show, 6 among other things, the following: If the claim is for services, 7 it shall show the kind of service, the dates when same was 8 performed and the name of the person performing it; if the claim is 9 for material or supplies furnished, the claim shall show in detail 10 the kind of material or supplies, the quantity, dates of delivery 11 and to whom delivered; and if the claim is for road or bridge work 12 or for road or bridge material, the amount of which claim is for 13 material in excess of \$5 or for labor in excess of \$25, the claim 14 shall be verified by the affidavit of the person making it, and in 15 such affidavit the person making the claim shall be required to 16 state that the services performed or materials furnished, as set 17 forth in such claim, were actually performed or actually furnished, 18 and that the claim as stated is true and correct and that there is 19 justly due to the claimant the sum set forth in the account. If 20 any person shall swear falsely in the making of such affidavit, he 21 shall be deemed guilty of false swearing. The president or 22 presiding officer of the fiscal body allowing claims shall indorse 23 on all accounts allowed the words "allowed and payment authorized," 24 together with the date of allowance and signature of the president

- 1 or other presiding officer. satisfactorily, as determined by the
- 2 fiscal body. In order to facilitate more timely payment of claims,
- 3 no official action on the part of the fiscal body is required.
- 4 Claims shall be paid within a time that will allow for taking
- 5 advantage of any discounts that may be offered for paying early.
- 6 All claims shall be defaced when paid. The fiscal body shall be
- 7 provided a listing of claims paid, at least monthly, indicating the
- 8 type of service or material furnished.

**NOTE:** The purpose of this bill is to streamline the payment of claims by a county commission, board of education or the council of a municipal corporation.
