21	§11-13B-1. Tax imposed on telecommunications businesses.
22	(a) Upon every telecommunications business selling or

- 2 of the business or other activities of the taxpayer, engaged in or

## 18 §11-13B-2. Proceeds of the tax.

- 19 Proceeds from the tax imposed by this article shall be paid to
- 20 the West Virginia Division of Tourism to be used for the promotion
- 21 and maintenance of outdoor activities including, but not limited
- 22 to, skiing and white water rafting.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create a tax on telecommunications businesses to provide as close as reasonably possible, \$10 million in revenue to benefit promotion and maintenance of outdoor activities.
