A BILL to amend and reenact §19-12A-6a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, increasing the cap for collections into the land division special revenue account of the Department of Agriculture from \$1,500,000 to \$2,000,000 and dividing amounts in excess of the cap evenly between said special revenue account and the General Revenue Fund of the state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §19-12A-6a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 12A. LAND DIVISION.

§19-12A-6a. Special revenue account.

1 All funds collected by the commission by virtue of this
2 article, whether from the sale of food, the disposition of assets
3 other than land, the lease of land or minerals, or any other
4 source, shall be paid into a special revenue account to be used
5 for the purposes of this article: *Provided*, That ~~when the aggregate~~
6 ~~of said funds so collected and deposited in the special~~
7 ~~revenue account in any fiscal year total \$1,500,000, the commis-~~
8 ~~sion shall deposit any funds collected in excess thereof in the~~
9 ~~General Revenue Fund of the state:~~ for any of these funds
10 collected by the Commission that exceed \$2 million in any fiscal
11 year, the Commissioner shall deposit half into the special
12 revenue account and half into the General Revenue Fund of the
13 state.
