- 8 That \$29-22-18d of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
- 9 amended, be amended and reenacted; that said code be amended by
- 10 adding thereto three new sections, designated \$29-22A-10d,
- 11 \$29-22A-10e and \$29-22A-10f; that said code be amended by adding
- 12 thereto a new section, designated §29-22C-27a; and that said code
- 13 be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §29-25-22b,
- 14 all to read as follows:
- 15 ARTICLE 22. STATE LOTTERY ACT.
- 16 §29-22-18d. Increase in allocation to West Virginia
- 17 Infrastructure Fund from State Excess Lottery
- 18 Revenue Fund.
- 19 Notwithstanding any provision of subsection (d), section
- 20 eighteen-a of this article to the contrary, the deposit of \$40
- 21 million into the West Virginia Infrastructure Fund set forth above
- 22 is for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, only. For the

- 1 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, and each fiscal year 2 thereafter, in lieu of the deposits required under subdivision (5), 3 subsection (d), section eighteen-a of this article, the commission first deposit \$6 million into the West 5 Infrastructure Lottery Revenue Debt Service Fund created in 6 subsection (h), section nine, article fifteen-a, chapter thirty-one 7 of this code to be spent in accordance with the provisions of that 8 subsection and, second, deposit \$40 million into the West Virginia 9 Infrastructure Fund created in subsection (a), section nine, 10 article fifteen-a, chapter thirty-one of this code to be spent in 11 accordance with the provisions of that article: Provided, That for 12 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, the deposit to the West 13 Virginia Infrastructure Fund shall be \$20 million: Provided, 14 however, That notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), 15 section ten, article fifteen-a, chapter thirty-one of this code, 16 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, any moneys disbursed 17 from the West Virginia Infrastructure Fund in the form of grants 18 shall not exceed fifty percent of the total funds available for the 19 funding of projects.

- 1 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of subsection (b), section 2 ten of this article to the contrary, for the fiscal year beginning 3 July 1, 2014, and each fiscal year thereafter, the commission may 4 transfer up to \$9 million as actual costs and expenses to the 5 Licensed Racetrack Modernization Fund.
- (b) Notwithstanding any provision of subsection (c), section ten of this article to the contrary, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, and each fiscal year thereafter, each distribution, except those distributions to be made pursuant to subdivisions (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) and (7), subsection (c), section ten of this article, shall be reduced by one hundred percent. Payments shall not be made pursuant to section ten of this article, other than those excepted by this subsection, and are made in lieu thereof in an amount to be determined by appropriation from the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund.
- (c) The total amount of reductions resulting from subsection (b) of this section shall be paid into the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund created by section eighteen-a, article twenty-two of this chapter. - (a) Notwithstanding any provision of subsection (a), section ten-b of this article to the contrary, for the fiscal year deginning July 1, 2014, and each fiscal year thereafter, each distribution, except those distributions to be made pursuant to subdivisions (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) and (7), subsection (a), rection ten-b of this article, shall be reduced by one hundred percent. Payments shall not be made pursuant to section ten-b of this article, other than those excepted by this subsection, and are made in lieu thereof in an amount to be determined by appropriation from the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund.
- 22 (b) The total amount of reductions resulting from subsection

 3 (c), section twenty-two of this article from gross terminal income,
