10 AN ACT making a supplementary appropriation from the State Fund, State Excess Lottery Revenue
11 Fund, by supplementing and amending chapter thirteen, Acts of the Legislature, regular
12 session, 2014, known as the Budget Bill, by supplementing and amending Title II, section
13 five.

14 WHEREAS, The passage of House Bill No. 101 during the 2014 First Extraordinary Session
15 increased the revenues available for appropriation from the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund
16 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015; and

17 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature an Executive Message on May 19,
18 2014, which included a revised Statement of the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund, setting forth
19 therein the estimated unappropriated cash balance as of July 1, 2014, and further included the revised
20 estimate of revenue for the fiscal year 2015, less regular appropriations and other adjustments for

1 the fiscal year 2015; and

2 WHEREAS, It appears from the Governor’s Statement of the State Excess Lottery Revenue
3 Fund there now remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for
4 appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015; therefore

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

6 That chapter thirteen, Acts of the Legislature, regular session , 2014, known as the Budget
7 Bill, be supplemented and amended by amending Title II, section five, to read as follows:

8 TITLE II--APPROPRIATIONS.

9 **Sec. 5. Appropriations from State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund.**— In accordance with
10 W.Va. Code §29-22-18a, §29-22A-10d, §29-22A-10e, §29-22C-27a and §29-25-22b, the following
11 appropriations shall be deposited and disbursed by the Director of the Lottery to the following
12 accounts in this section in the amounts indicated.

13 After first funding the appropriations required by W.Va. Code §29-22-18a, §29-22A-10d,
14 §29-22A-10e, §29-22C-27a and §29-25-22b, the Director of the Lottery shall provide funding from
15 the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund for the remaining appropriations in this section to the extent
16 that funds are available. In the event that revenues to the State Excess Lottery Revenue Fund are not
17 sufficient to meet all the appropriations made pursuant to this section, then the Director of the
18 Lottery shall first provide the necessary funds to meet fund 7208, appropriation 70011 of this
19 section; next, to provide the funds necessary for fund 3517, appropriation 09500 of this section; next,
20 to provide the funds necessary for fund 5365, appropriation 18900. Allocation of the funds for each

1 appropriation shall be allocated in succession before any funds are provided for the next subsequent
2 appropriation.
