17	§1. Extending time for the Common Council for the City of Richwood to meet as a levying
18	body for an election supplementing the city's budget; setting levy rate; certifying
19	actions to the state; and for the purpose of paying all costs incurred in the laying of
20	the additional levy.

Notwithstanding the provisions of article eight, chapter eleven of the Code of West Virginia, 2 1931, as amended, the Common Council of the City of Richwood, Nicholas County, is authorized 3 to extend the time for its meeting as a levying body, setting the levy rate and certifying its actions 4 to the State Auditor and the State Tax Commissioner by June 30, 2014, for the purpose of submitting 5 to the voters of the City of Richwood the question of supplementing the city's budget and for the 6 purpose of paying all costs incurred in the laying of this additional levy.
