

Senate Bill No. 115

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee
on Government Organization; and then to the Committee on the
Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
State Board of Examiners for Licensed Practical Nurses to
promulgate a legislative rule relating to continuing
competence.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. State Board of Examiners for Licensed Practical Nurses.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on April 29,
2013, authorized under the authority of section five, article

1 seven-a, chapter thirty of this code, modified by the State Board
2 of Examiners for Licensed Practical Nurses to meet the objections
3 of the Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the
4 State Register on September 4, 2013, relating to the State Board of
5 Examiners for Licensed Practical Nurses (continuing competence, [10](#)
6 [CSR 6](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Board of Examiners for Licensed Practical Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Continuing Competence.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
