21	The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26,

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1 of Environmental Protection to meet the objections of the 2 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State 3 Register on December 18, 2013, relating to the Department of 4 Environmental Protection (state certification of activities 5 requiring federal licenses and permits, 47 CSR 5A), is authorized.
