

Senate Bill No. 162

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on the
Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Bureau for Child Support Enforcement to promulgate a legislative rule relating to support enforcement activities undertaken by the bureau.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES
TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-5-1. Bureau for Child Support Enforcement.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 29, 2013, authorized under the authority of section one hundred five, article eighteen, chapter forty-eight of this code, modified by the

1 Bureau for Child Support Enforcement to meet the objections of the
2 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State
3 Register on December 18, 2013, relating to the Bureau for Child
4 Support Enforcement (support enforcement activities undertaken by
5 the Bureau for Child Support Enforcement, [97 CSR 6](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Bureau for Child Support Enforcement to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Support Enforcement Activities Undertaken by the Bureau.
