

Senate Bill No. 171

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on the
Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Treasurer's Office to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the selection of state depositories for disbursement accounts through competitive bidding.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Treasurer's Office.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2013, authorized under the authority of section two, article one, chapter twelve of this code, modified by the Treasurer's Office to

1 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee
2 and refiled in the State Register on November 12, 2013, relating to
3 the Treasurer's Office (selection of state depositories for
4 disbursement accounts through competitive bidding, [112 CSR 6](#)), is
5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Treasurer's Office to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the selection of state depositories for disbursement accounts through competitive bidding.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
