

Senate Bill No. 189

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on
Agriculture and Rural Development; and then to the Committee on
the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of
West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to promulgate a
legislative rule relating to farm wineries.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TAX AND REVENUE TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-7-1. Alcohol Beverage Control Commission.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26,
2013, authorized under the authority of section sixteen, article
two, chapter sixty of this code, modified by the Alcohol Beverage

1 Control Commission to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-
2 making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
3 October 31, 2013, relating to the Alcohol Beverage Commission (farm
4 wineries, [175 CSR 3](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Alcohol Beverage Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Farm Wineries.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
