

Senate Bill No. 191

(By Senator Snyder)

[Introduced January 8, 2014; referred to the Committee on
Finance; and then to the Committee on the Judiciary.]

A BILL to amend and reenact article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to nonintoxicating beer licensing and operations procedures.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 7, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TAX AND REVENUE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-7-1. Alcohol Beverage Control Commission.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2013, authorized under the authority of section twenty-two, article sixteen, chapter eleven of this code, modified by the Alcohol

2 Legislative Rule-making Review Committee and refiled in the State
3 Register on October 31, 2013, relating to the Alcohol Beverage
4 Commission (nonintoxicating beer licensing and operations
5 procedures, [176 CSR 1](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Alcohol Beverage Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Nonintoxicating Beer Licensing and Operations Procedures.
