A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of  
 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
 Massage Therapy Licensure Board to promulgate a legislative  
 rule relating to a schedule of fees.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Massage Therapy Licensure Board.**

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 23,  
2013, authorized under the authority of section seven, article  
thirty-six, chapter thirty of this code, relating to the Massage

1 Therapy Licensure Board (schedule of fees, [194 CSR 4](#)), is  
2 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Massage  
Therapy Licensure Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating  
to a Schedule of Fees.
