10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$3-5-24$ of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to certificates of nomination for
12	elected office; stating filing deadlines for certificates of
13	nomination; declaring location where certificates of
14	nomination must be filed; clarifying with whom the
15	certificates are filed and to whom the fees are to be paid;
16	and prohibiting untimely filings or untimely fee payment.
17	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
18	That $\S 3-5-24$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
19	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
20	ARTICLE 5. PRIMARY ELECTIONS AND NOMINATING PROCEDURES.
21	§3-5-24. Filing of nomination certificates; time; location; fees;
22	effect of failure to timely file or pay fee.
23	(a) All certificates nominating candidates for office under
24	the preceding section twenty-three of this article shall be filed
25	not later than August 1 preceding the November general election.

- 1 Provided, That for municipal or other elections not held in
- 2 conjunction with regular state and county general elections,
- 3 certificates shall be filed not later than ninety days before the
- 4 date of the election, unless otherwise provided by charter,
- 5 ordinance or code.
- 6 (b) The nomination certificate required by this section and
- 7 <u>section twenty-three of this article shall be filed:</u>
- 8 (1) In in the case of a candidate to be voted for by the
- 9 voters of the entire state or by any subdivision of the state other
- 10 than a single county, with the Secretary of State; and in
- 11 (2) In the case of all candidates for county and magisterial
- 12 district offices, including all offices to be filled by the voters
- 13 of a single county, with the clerk of the county commission; and
- 14 (3) In the case of candidates for election in a municipality,
- 15 with the recorder or other official designated by charter or
- 16 ordinance to perform election responsibilities. not later than
- 17 August 1 preceding the general election.
- 18 (b) (c) Each candidate shall pay the filing fee required by
- 19 section eight of this article, at the time of the filing of the
- 20 nomination certificate.
- 21 (d) If any nomination certificate is not timely filed or if
- 22 the filing fee is not timely paid, the certificate may not be
- 23 received by the Secretary of State, or by the clerk of the county
- 24 commission or the recorder or other official designated by charter
- 25 or ordinance to perform municipal election responsibilities, as the
- 26 case may be.
