19	§1. Extending time for the city council for the Town of
20	Fayetteville to meet as a levying body for an election to
21	supplement current funds for the laying, repair and
22	maintenance of the streets and sidewalks, and for the
23	purpose of paying all costs incurred in the laying of the

2 Notwithstanding the provisions of article eight, chapter 3 eleven of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, the city council of the Town of Fayetteville, Fayette County, is authorized 4 to extend the time for its meeting as a levying body, setting the 5 levy rate and certifying its actions to the State Auditor and the 6 State Tax Commissioner from between March 7 and March 28 and the 7 8 third Tuesday in April until May 31, 2014, for the purpose of 9 submitting to the voters of the Town of Fayetteville the question 10 supplementing current funds for the laying, repair and of maintenance of the streets and sidewalks, and for the purpose of 11 12 paying all costs incurred in the laying of this additional levy.
